Ludovica Molo, architect, was a founding member, with Jachen Könz, of the könz.molo partnership in Lugano, Switzerland, between 1998 and 2009. Their work has been published locally and internationally and has received numerous awards.

She is currently with studio we in Lugano.

Molo was born in Lugano and earned a degree in architecture at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH) in Zurich. After graduation, she moved to Los Angeles, where she worked in a number of architectural offices and travelled throughout the west seeing architecture and land art. Returning to Switzerland, she worked as a tutor at the École Polytechnique Fédérale in Lausanne (EPFL) and at the Accademia di architettura in Mendrisio.

She then taught at SCI-Arc Vico Morcote from 2003 to 2009. Since 2006, she has been i2a Vico Morcote's program director and since 2011 she is director of the institute.
